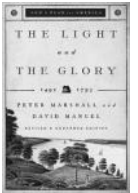
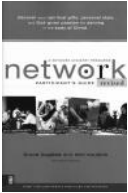

TUESDAYS

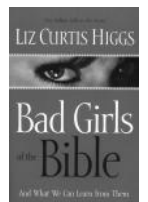
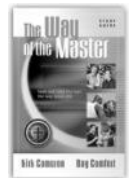
Tuesday at 8:00pm

- **Young Adult Bible Study - Life Center - Chad Davis - FREE** - Come join with a group of 18-30 year olds to fellowship and study the Bible together. The group begins with some free time in the Life Center and moves to a Bible study in the classes upstairs.

Wednesday at 6:30pm

- **Network - Room 106 - Mike Morley - \$9** - For all those who have wondered what God created them for, this class is for you. Here you will discover your spiritual gifts, personality type, and passion profile, all of which make up your spiritual profile. This class will help you answer the questions: "Why am I here, and What am I supposed to be doing?"
- **Foundations - Room 108 - Art Sauer - \$15** - Many Christians today live their lives, plan their schedules, and use their resources completely disconnected from what they say they believe. This spiritual disconnect is the cause of so much of the stress and problems in our lives. Foundations is a fresh, innovative curriculum about the essential truths of the Christian faith and how these truths are to be lived out - in your relationships, your character, and your work. Rather than just teaching doctrinal knowledge, this course shows you how to apply biblical truths and implement them in your everyday life.
- **Grief Share - Visitor's Reception Room - Ann Guffee - \$12** - Grief Share is designed to assist others claim an eternal perspective after the death of a spouse, child, family member, or friend. It is an effective tool to help people find or deepen their faith in Christ as they examine soul-level questions about death, dying, their own mortality, and eternal life.
- **The Way of the Master - Room 212 - Jason Tierney - \$6** - The Basic Training Course is specially formatted to train believers in a group setting to simply and confidently share the gospel with family, friends, and strangers. These lessons will teach you to overcome your fears by using a proven, powerfully effective way to make the gospel make sense. The class will learn the forgotten biblical principle of bypassing the intellect (the place of argument) and speaking directly to the conscience (the place of the knowledge of right and wrong) — the way Jesus did.
- **man2man - 6:30pm - Room 211 - Robert Nash - \$6 - (MEN ONLY)** This is an ongoing, dynamic study to encourage and affirm the men of the church. Utilizing group study and discussion, men have the opportunity to foster accountability in their Christian walk with other men having the same perspective.
- **Bad Girls of the Bible - Room 210 - Sara Wallace - \$10 - (WOMEN ONLY)** Whether they were "Bad to the Bone," "Bad for a Season, but Not Forever" or only "Bad for a Moment," these infamous sisters show women how not to handle the challenges of life. With her trademark humor and encouragement, Higgs teaches you how to avoid their tragic mistakes and joyfully embrace grace. Includes reflection questions at the end of each chapter.
- **Building Your Spiritual Resume - Room 209 - Rex Clark - \$10** - As we live out the truths and principles of *Building Your Spiritual Resume*, God builds into us a name that will outlast us. The testimony we leave behind will either be a lovely fragrance or a foul stench. God help us to so assimilate these truths that value may be added to others.
